Instead of This		Try This	
X	Addict, junkie, drunk, alcoholic, doper, crackhead	✓	Person affected by a use disorder
X	Substance Abuse	✓	Substance Use Disorder
X	Clean	✓	Sober, free of substances, in recovery
X	Clean / Dirty Urine	✓	Urine screening results aligned or not aligned with treatment
X	IVDA (Intravenous drug addict/abuser)	✓	IDU (Injection drug use)
