# Person-Centered Language

Instead of This		Try This	
<b>X</b>	Addict, junkie, drunk, alcoholic, doper, crackhead	✓	Person affected by a use disorder
<b>X</b>	Substance Abuse	✓	Substance Use Disorder
<b>X</b>	Clean	✓	Sober, free of substances, in recovery
<b>X</b>	Clean / Dirty Urine	✓	Urine results indicate / do not indicate presence of substances
<b>X</b>	IVDA (Intravenous drug addict/abuser)	✓	IDU (Injection drug use)
