Note: If a patient has multiple conditions which may be causing the neuropathy, it is appropriate to document for each condition. For example, a patient with polyneuropathy and diabetes and hypothyroidism would be documented as type 2 diabetes mellitus with diabetic neuropathy (E11.42) and polyneuropathy <u>due to</u> hypothyroidism (G63 polyneuropathy in diseases classified elsewhere and E03.9 hypothyroidism, unspecified).

The ICD-10-CM code book and the Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting are the authoritative references for accurate and complete coding. The information presented herein is for general informational purposes only. Specific documentation is reflective of the "thought process" of the provider when treating patients. All conditions affecting the care, treatment or management of the patient should be documented with their status and treatment, and coded to the highest level of specificity. Enhanced precision and accuracy in the codes selected is the ultimate goal.
